Uniform Stall

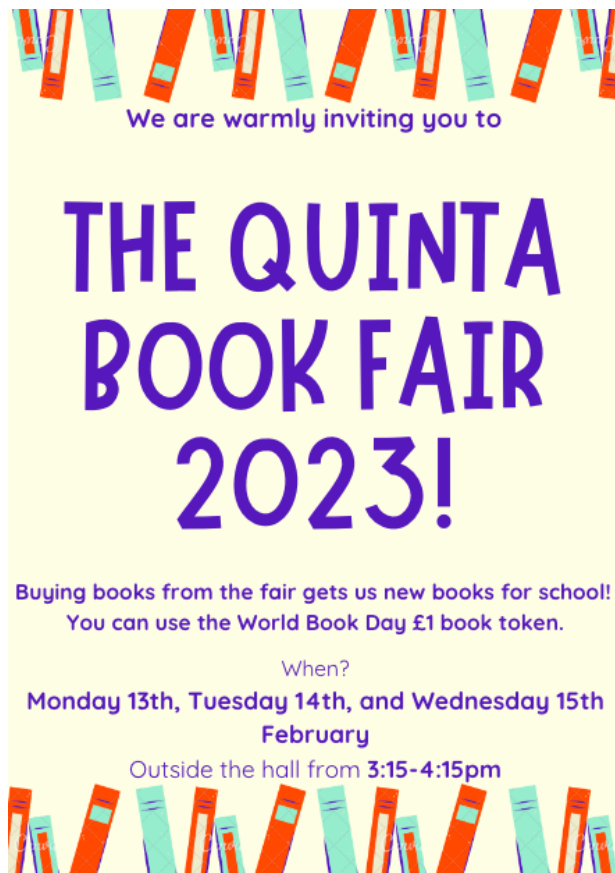
