## COVID-19 Update - Working at home

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Dear parents and guardians,

As you are all aware, we are taking precautions for scenarios where your child is unable to attend school (illness, isolation due to siblings, school closure).

Today we have sent home codes and instructions for your child to upload any work completed at home. We have also sent home with every child an exercise book and pencil. This exercise book is solely for the purpose of completing work from daily teaching or directed slides should the school be closed. This ensures no child is left without the resources to complete learning tasks.

We have also created a useful handout just in case there is a day when you cannot access the internet or have other problems with devices etc.

### Summary

- Your child should have brought home a yellow exercise book and a pencil (if they haven't they will tomorrow)
- You should have received instructions on how to download the seesaw for home app and log in (this enables you to upload work from home)
- If your child is off school they can do the work in their exercise book.
- If the school closes, children will have learning sent daily
- If pupils cannot access seesaw from home, they will have generic activities that will be expected to be completed (ideas sent home on 1 piece of A4 eg. draw a character from your book and label their characteristics) so in the worst case scenario, no pupil is left without work.
