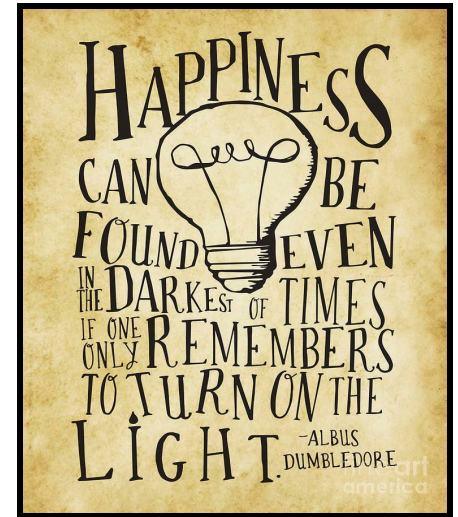
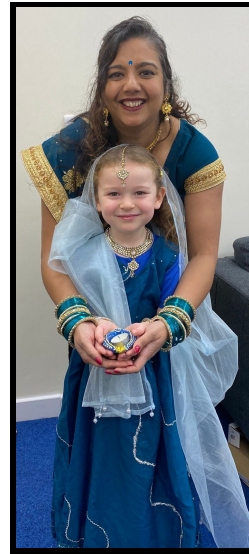


Dear parents and guardians,
