Since lockdown, the rates of domestic abuse increased and statistically domestic violence increases when the England football team lose.

Some common behaviours that are common with domestic abuse are as follows:

- Name calling that make an individual feel bad about themselves
- Experiencing threatening behaviours
- Violent behaviour
- An individual may be prevented from seeing their friends of family
- An individual may be prevented from having access to money
- An individual may feel that they could be seriously harmed

It is important to remember that the individual is not to blame and they are already a survivor. If anyone feels that they are experiencing domestic abuse or suspect someone they know if a survivor of domestic abuse there is help available.
